Article of the Month

The Article of the Month in April 2014 is written by **Meng Chan Lim and Halim Setan**, **Malaysia: A Practical Deformation Monitoring Procedure and Software System for CORS Coordinate Monitoring**. This paper illustrates the combination of continuous GPS measurement with robust method for deformation detection to GPS station position change. A window-based software system for GPS deformation detection and analysis via robust method, called Continuous Deformation Analysis System (ConDAS), has been developed at Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. This paper describes the design and architecture of ConDAS and highlights the deformation analysis results from two assessments.
