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LAND MARKET IN SERBIA AND THE NEEDS TO ESTABLISH MODERN EDUCATION SYSTEM

- Modernization of property registration system
- Legislation system needs to be improved
- The procedure for registration of land rights should be simplified and accelerated
- Real property must be transformed into the capital

THE SERBIAN EFFORTS TO ESTABLISH MODERN EDUCATION SYSTEM OF SURVEYORS

- Rules for private practice
- 92 private companies with 500 surveyors, 2002
- 740 surveying companies with 2000 workers, 2008
- Key issues of real property sector must be obtained: Policy, Legal, IT and Financial
- Tempus project – Land Law and Economy

THE MAIN CHARACTERISTICS OF THE NEW MASTER PROGRAMME

- New master programme is a result of cooperation between three European universities and two domestic institutions
- The programme shall pay attention to legal and economic questions especially related to land consolidation and urban/suburban land development
- The Master's Program in Land Law and Economy is a four semester program
- The Master's program includes an integrated full/time internship period
- During the last semester, students must write the Master's Thesis
