**ERP** 



Manage tasks and work requests for field workers

- Cockburn moving n-Prem ERP to coud based SaaS
- Heavy customisation in on-prem SQL Server
- Limited to no-customisation options in SaaS (no direct access to underlying database)
- Tightly coupled, two-way ERP to GIS integration not possible with Saas
- Supports critical council services





















## **Our Objectives**



- Minimise bespoke puration (avoid more tech debt
- Utilise out of the box integrations in both platforms
- Waste management service two-way sync between ArcGIS Online (AGOL) and TechOne datastores
- Deliver the solution with Cockburn part consulting, part training


#### **Our Solution**

Scheduled sync processes that integrates via T1 REST APJ

Feature Service

**ArcGIS Online** 

- Lightweight extensible configuration
- FME Flow manages information flows downstream every 2 minutes and upstream nightly via schedule



- Downstream T1 → AGOL
- 1. httpcaller T1 web service 2. Read AGOL features service
- Change Detector
- 4. Write AGOL upsert





- Upstream AGOL → T1 1. Read AGOL feature service
- 2. httpcaller T1 web service
- 3. Change Detector
- 4. Upload sFTP or httpcaller POST
